VIKINGS HAVE FUN AT DINNER THEATER

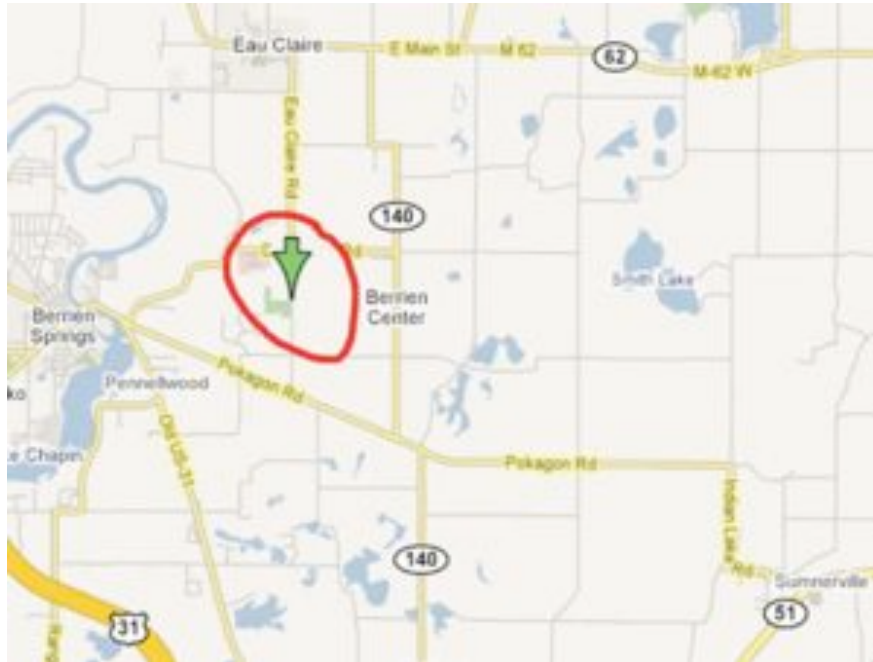

- 6TH - Timber Ridge Master's Sunday Race Training 9AM first event January 7, 2007
- 6TH - Timber Ridge NASTAR Sunday 1 PM January 8, 2007
- 20TH - Swiss Valley Indiana Ski Council Snow Meister Race at Swiss Valley open for all ages and abilities.

FEBRUARY:

- 17th - Outpost Cup Race Saturday at Swiss Valley (not and ISC event). This is a great socializing event with racing for all ages and abilities. Every entrant gets a gift and other cool stuff.
- 22-24TH - Indiana Ski Council Race at Boyne Highlands. You will need to join Viking Ski Club to attend this event. Viking's will be defending their honor after 4 consecutive wins against other Indiana Ski Clubs. There are 4 classifications from beginner to advance racers for most ages going for overall club points. 2 races (2 runs each) on Saturday and 2 races on Sunday.

NASTAR

Many of our members enjoy racing in the NASTAR system whether it is locally or at a Club Trips Out West. We are going to start a competition among our individual Ski Clubs. I am not sure what this will evolve into this first year. The responsibility will be for each Club's Race Chairman to organize per instruction below. ISC will share results by mid April. We will use NASTAR's second best Handicap Run as the fastest time for that person (with the exception if you have only run one event we will honor that time as well). The cutoff date will be March 15.

Club Race Chair Responsibility:

- Create a roster of racer's name, age, sex and handicap per club and submit to ISC before April 1

ISC Responsibility:

- To compile results of each individual club and present an overall ranking for each of the categories outlined in ISC race rules. Example = compile per category (age and sex) the highest to lowest handicap. Using the ISC system award points for 1st through last in that category assigning a ranking. There will be overall point's award per club. The more club racers that enter NASTAR the better your chances to do well as a club (this will also promote Alpine Ski Racing)
- NASTAR club competition at Timber Ridge Ski Resort in Michigan. January 6, 2007 at 1PM. Any ISC club is welcome to join us.
- Distribute results to each ISC Club Race Chair

Boyne Highlands, Michigan Fun & Race Weekend

February 22, 23 & 24, 2008 (6/20/07 Rev)

This season our annual ISC weekend will be at **Boyne Highlands** near Petoskey, Michigan. This will be an exciting weekend of racing and fun for families and friends in one of Michigan's premier ski resorts. Vikings will be defending their title as the Fastest Indiana Ski Club (the past 4 years). Come join in the fun by either racing in this low key event or by cheering on your fellow Viking Racers. There are 4 levels to participate in (Advance through First Time Racers). Accommodations will be slope side at the Main Lodge. We are working on a bus trip that could be combined with other clubs or drive up together (Bus Trip Expense is not included in the following rates).

This weekend will include Friday and Saturday night lodging, weekend lift ticket, 2 breakfasts and Saturday Night Banquet Dinner. Lift tickets are good for Friday 4:30-9PM, Saturday 9AM-9PM & Sunday 9AM-4PM.

Weekend Package Rates are as follows:

- 2 adults per room = \$270 per person
- 3 or more adults per room = \$240 per person
- Children above 13 fall into the adult rate
- Children 9 to 12 years old with 2 adults per room \$140
- Children 8 years old and younger \$71 per child with 2 adults in room.

Additional Fun Possible: NASTAR National Handicap Racing Saturday & Sunday at 1 PM. Tubing park, Skier Cross Course and Cross Country Skiing are also available. You can also stop on your way up or back at Boyne Mountain (some members last year chose to ski at Boyne on Sunday with the same weekend lift pass) Avalanche Bay Indoor Water Park is also a fun alternative at Boyne Mountain. Recommended Tentative Itinerary:

Friday - Arrive at Lodge & check in. Ft. Wayne Ski Club has set gates for training in past years. TBD this year.

Saturday- Breakfast and register per your age and category for racing if you have not already registered (\$5 per person). Please provide your NASTAR Number or we will assign one for you. Please include your gender and age (this will assist the race workers and allow you to gain NASTAR points. Wide open Slalom course (A&B racers) (2 runs) and Giant Slalom course (2 runs each) last year they were on 2 different courses (no resetting of gates). The points accumulated from this racing will go towards the ISC championship. Join the complimentary ISC Ski Après outdoor party by the heated pool after skiing with snacks and beverages including Micro Brews on tap. The ISC banquet dinner with awards will wrap up the evening.

Racing Categories: (you will be broken up into ability, age and gender brackets)

A Class	Expert ski racer best of 2 runs on both courses
B Class	Advance ski racer best of 2 runs on both courses
C Class	Intermediate ski racer best of 2 runs on both courses
D Class	First time ski racer best of 2 runs on both courses

Sunday – Breakfast, return to the slopes for a fun day of skiing with your friends and family.

A minimum of \$100 deposit per person (or full payment) by November 15, 2006, with remainder due by January 15, 2007. Please make checks out to Indiana Ski Council and provide a rooming list of occupants and ages of any children.

Those adult skiers that fell into the \$50 rebate last year by depositing and paying the remaining balance by 1/30/06 will have that amount deducted from final payment this year. Another opportunity for a **\$25 REBATE** will be applied this year to all on time (1/15/08) full paying adults for next winter's race weekend (this rebate has been generously provided by ISC to continue this great tradition of racing & fun).
